Mark Demchak and Michael Kanieski were hired as seasonal laborers. Trustee DeLeone moved to approve the hiring of 2 seasonal laborers. Trustee Leo Lux seconded the motion. Passed.

The Williams family owns many lots in the same the same Section as the Kent family. They are willing to donate a grave for this purpose. Trustee Russell made a motion to accept this proposal. Trustees DeLeone & Lux agreed. Motion Passed.

Reverend David Bridling of St Patrick's church in Kent has asked to have a tent placed in Section 17 to hold a mass on Memorial Day morning at 8 a.m. Baumgardner's will put up the tent the Friday before and remove it Tuesday morning.

Due to some health issues, Superintendent Roger Donell will be moved to a salaried position in June.
