

Standing Rock Cemetery  
Minutes of the Regular Meeting  
November 13, 2025

The regular meeting of Standing Rock Cemetery Trustees was held at the cemetery office on Thursday November 13, 2025. Trustee Mike DeLeone called the meeting to order at 4:09 p.m. with trustee, Glenn Russell, Jim Stroble & Jean Chrest Clerk –treasurer present. Also in attendance were several Kent State students auditing the meeting: Victoria Reese, Brooke Ludwig, Esther Morris, Rehan Rana, & Savannah Slencak.

The minutes from the October 2025 meeting were presented. Trustee DeLeone moved and Mr. Russell seconded to approve the minutes. All those in favor: Aye Motion Passed.

The financial statement for October 2025 was presented. Trustee Stoble moved to accept the financial statement. Trustee Russell seconded. All those in favor -Aye Motion passed. The vouchers were presented. Trustee Russell moved and Mr. Stroble seconded to approve the vouchers for payment. All those in favor-Aye Motion Passed.

Trustees DeLeone, Russell & Stroble reviewed the fuel report.

A complaint was received by Ms Chrest from Denbow Funeral home regarding the burial of Donna Mattison on October 17, 2025. The Funeral Director, Seth Gasche left the services with out paying or delivering the burial permit because he said the family was upset that we weren't ready for them when they arrived for an 11:00 a.m. service. They also implied that our backhoe was within eyesight of the service. There was a miscommunication in the office and the grave was not open in the morning. The vault company arrived at 9:15, alerting us to the service and we promptly opened the grave finishing by 10:30. The tent was set up and ready for the service to take place when the funeral procession arrived. The tent was not set up over the grave as we do false set-ups for all of our casket burials. After a week of not receiving any paperwork Ms Chrest called Seth and this is when she was told about the issues the family apparently had. The Funeral Director said he was not sending anything and that they wanted a discount. He was told that we had the grave opened and were ready for them and that a discount was not forthcoming. He then asked for a Board members name & contact information. He was emailed all of the Board's names & addresses. Approximately a week later Trustee DeLeone was contacted and per his discussion with Mr. Gasche we offered to waive the foundation fee for the Mattison family. Trustee DeLeone moved to waive the foundation fee for the Donna Mattison family. Trustee Russell seconded the motion. Trustee Stroble: Aye. Motion passed Note: We have not heard from the family regarding this matter.

The Trustees reviewed the Security System quotes for the maintenance building area and decided to delay a decision until another quote comes in from Detect Security.
