

Standing Rock Cemetery  
Minutes of the Regular Meeting  
May 14, 2026

The regular meeting of Standing Rock Cemetery Trustees was held at the cemetery office on Thursday May 14, 2026. Trustee Russell called the meeting to order at 4:08 p.m. with trustees Jim Stroble, Jeff Clapper Jean Chrest, Clerk-treasurer present.

The minutes from the April 2026 meeting were presented. Trustee Stroble made a motion to accept the minutes from the April 2026 meeting. Trustee Russell seconded to approve the minutes. All those in favor: Stroble-Aye, Russell-Aye Clapper-Aye Motion Passed.

The financial statement for April 2026 was presented. Trustee Stroble moved to accept the financial statement. Trustee Clapper seconded to approve the financial statement for April 2026. All those in favor: Russell-Aye, Stroble-Aye, Clapper-Aye Motion passed.

The vouchers were presented. Trustee Russell moved to accept the vouchers for payment. Trustee Clapper seconded the motion. All those in favor: Stroble-Aye, Clapper-Aye, Russell-Aye Motion Passed.

Trustees Russell, Stroble & Clapper reviewed the fuel reports.

Ms. Chrest reported that the 11<sup>th</sup> District Court of Appeals rejected Fred Molai's appeal of the Portage County Court of Common Pleas decision. The cemetery is liable for the \$100,000 judgement.

Ms Chrest presented the quote from Deckmaster for repairs & new siding on both maintenance buildings. \$14,000. for the older building & \$12,000. for the newer building. The total is \$26,000. Trustee Clapper made a motion to accept the quote from Deckmaster for the maintenance buildings repair. Trustee Russell seconded the motion. All those in favor: Clapper-Aye, Russell-Aye, Stroble-Aye. Motion passed.

The Mosher family has asked us to replace a family stone that has been damaged by lawn mowers & vault company set-ups. Ms. Chrest received a quote from Portage Marble & Granite for \$2092.00 to replace the stone. The original stone was installed flat flush; the new stone will be placed on top of the original which will be used like a granite base. Trustee Russell made a motion to accept the quote from Portage Marble & Granite for the replacement of the Mosher family monument. Trustee Stroble seconded the motion. All those in favor: Clapper-Aye, Russell-Aye, Stroble-Aye. Motion passed.

Ms. Chrest presented a diagram of the new Columbarium placement as well as 2 benches in the River Columbarium area. Quotes for the Columbariums & benches will be received at the June meeting.

In April a storm knocked down a large branch that fell & destroyed a bench in the Cremation garden. Upon inspection of the other benches there is a need to replace the smaller one as well.

The company that makes the benches no longer carries them. Portage Marble & Granite has been asked to quote 2 replacement benches for the cremation garden.
